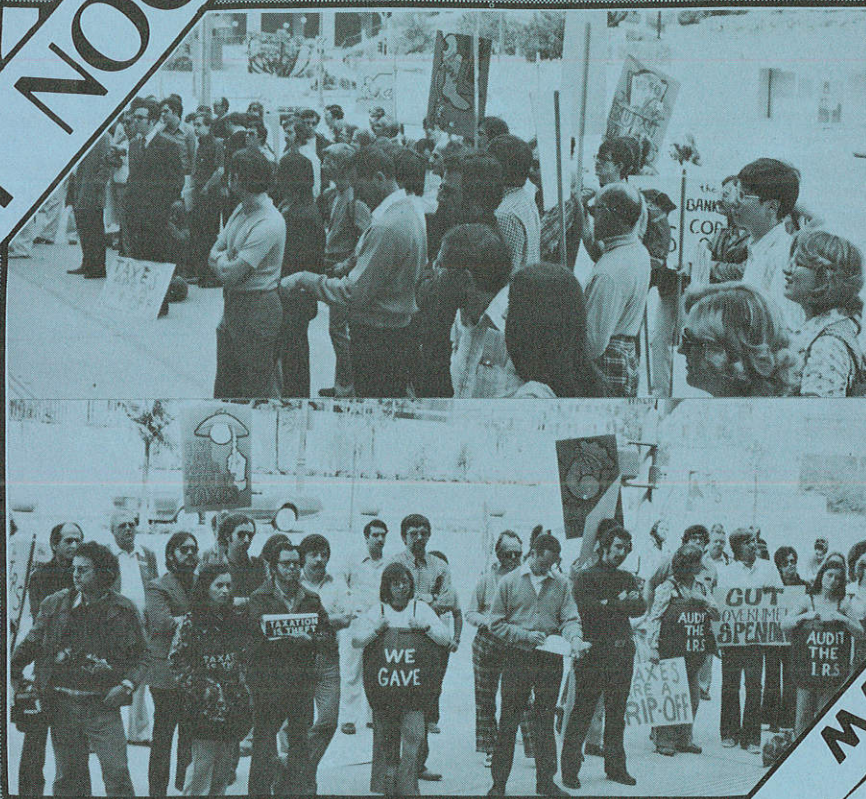


ANTI-TAX DEMONSTRATION

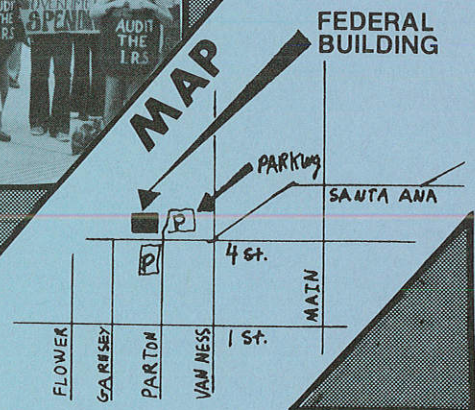

According to Sir Charles Dalrymple in 1775, the American colonists were taxed six pence (or 6 pennies) per year. Today, with inflation, six pence is worth roughly 31¢. This means that British taxes on Americans were less than 1 per cent of the colonists personal income in one year. In fact, the total British tax for one year on the average citizen was considerably less than one day's wage. Yet the popular notion is that the colonists were justified in revolting against the British because Americans were supposedly over-taxed.

It should be apparent that another tax revolt is long overdue. Let's mark 1976 as the start of the Second American Tax Revolt. Show your bicentennial colors, show your concern against taxation, attend the Anti-Tax Demonstration on Saturday, April 10 at high noon at the Federal Building on Santa Ana Bl. in Santa Ana. We did it before; we can do it again.
